Sort: Change the order in which the data is displayed in a view.

<u>Subscribe</u>: Subscribe to reports and receive them in your email inbox at regular intervals.

Create Data Alerts

<u>Alerts</u>: Create alerts to automatically send email notifications when your data reaches important thresholds.
