

The Alumnae of Northwestern University Graduate Fellowship

Award: up to \$20,000 towards graduate tuition

Who's Eligible: Northwestern alumni, preferably females, who return to Northwestern to pursue a terminal Master's degree. Open to full-time graduate students in all fields of study at Northwestern.

Details: The Alumnae of Northwestern University offers this Fellowship to full-time students who show promise of achieving distinction in their chosen field and who will bring credit to the University. Criteria for selection include quality of scholarship, leadership, community service, professional experience, and financial need. Special consideration will be given to students who choose a program in pursuit of a career that *serves the public good*.

Application Process: Candidates submit a completed application form along with a personal statement that highlights their educational and career goals, demonstrates their commitment "*to serve the public good*," and describes their need for financial assistance. Statements are limited to 500 words. Candidates provide copies of all Northwestern transcripts, a current resume, and letters from two references.

The 2009-2010 application for the Alumnae of Northwestern University Graduate Fellowship is posted online at the Office of Fellowships website. The deadline for students who have begun their graduate coursework is **December 1, 2009**.

The 2010-2011 application for incoming students will be posted in January. The deadline for incoming students who have been admitted to a graduate program is **May 1, 2010**.
