

Timeline for Non-Credit Undergraduate Travelers

At Least A Quarter Before Departure

- Determine if your destination is under a U.S. DOS Travel Warning and follow appropriate procedures
- Apply for or renew your passport. Renew your passport if it expires within 6 months of your planned departure from your destination.
- Review the necessary immunizations for your destination(s) on the CDC's website, and consult with a physician.

About a Month Before Departure

- Once you know your exact travel dates, purchase HTH and enroll in STEP.
- Once you've taken the Canvas course, purchased HTH and enrolled in STEP, complete the International Travel Registry.

At Least Six Weeks Before Departure

- Take the Canvas course, "International Risk Management for Students."
- Those with pre-existing health conditions should determine a plan for care and/or medications abroad with their current provider, and contact HTH and/or OGSS for help with planning.
- Read U.S. DOS country information sheets.

Two Weeks Before Departure

- Deadline for all Health and Safety Pre-departure Requirements.
