## The H/LSA Advisory Board

The Hispanic/Latino Student Affairs Freshman Advisory Board was created in 2006 to allow first year students to have an active role in the educational, social and service oriented programming sponsored by H/LSA. The members of this board are selected by H/LSA staff and work closely with several facets of the department.

- Study Skills Workshop

As a member of the Freshman Advisory board you will be required to meet on a bi-monthly basis to plan various educational and social programming, service projects and fundraisers to help build unity within the Latino freshman class (usually 1 event per quarter). During your experience on the board you will have the opportunity to develop leadership skills that will assist you throughout your time on campus and aid in your development.
