ANSWERS**

1. **FALSE**. Hate crimes occur all across the country. They can occur in urban, rural, and suburban settings.
2. **FALSE**. People are also victimized because of their religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity/national origin, gender, and disability.
3. **TRUE**. People of the Jewish faith are victimized in 84% of hate crimes targeting a specific religion. The FBI categories 16% of anti-religious hate crimes as "other." Since the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, hate crimes against Muslims and those perceived as Muslims have increased although the frequency of such attacks has diminished over time.
