



Operation ID

Operation identification (ID) is an anti-theft program. Its primary goals are to deter theft and help Police recover and return stolen property to its rightful owner.

How does it work? University Police Department will check out a handheld electric engraver and provide an Operation ID Log Sheets Log sheet (for property description documentation) and decals (for display at your residence or office area). Engrave your property with a unique individual identifying number, for example, the abbreviation of your driver's license issue state and license number (***Never use your Social Security number ***). Following engraving, display your decal and keep your property log sheet in a safe location.

Which property should I mark and record? Property of value a thief could carry away. Examples of items that should be marked and recorded are: cameras, bicycles, radios, televisions, VCR, watches, stereos, hand & power tools, computers, kitchen appliances, musical instruments, etc.
