<p><b>Room &amp; Board: \$2,385</b></p> <p>The room and board fee covers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>lodging in a Chicago hostel and three daily meals minus two dinners during pre-departure orientation and Final Reflection Summit</li> <li>homestay accommodations and three daily meals in-country</li> </ul> <p>Students are responsible for two dinners during pre-departure and a small number of meals during field visits and excursions.</p>
