<p>International Airfare Students are responsible for making arrangements to fly in to Johannesburg, South Africa, and out of Cape Town, South Africa, on the dates provided. International airfares vary greatly based on the point of departure, carrier, and type of ticket purchased as well as volatility of airline industry pricing.
