

DoD Funded Chartstrings

Purpose of this Guide

The purpose of this guide is to determine if the grant chartstring you wish to use to book airfare for international travel is funded by the Department of Defense (DoD).

Background

When booking travel to a grant chartstring, the Fly America Act requires the use of a United States flag carrier. One exception to the Fly America Act is if an Open Skies Agreement is in place. The exception is not applicable for DoD awards or DoD awards flowed through another institution to Northwestern. A U.S. flag carrier must be used on awards funded by the DoD for airfare. The safest way to determine if the award is from a DoD agency is to look up the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number in NU Financials or review the Project Account Summary. If you do not have access to NU Financials or Cognos, please contact the business office associated with the grant chart string to perform these steps.

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Option A - NU Financials

The navigation in NU Financials is Grants > Awards > Award Profile. Enter the Project number from the chartstring you wish to use.

If the first two digits of the CFDA number are 12, then the award funding is from the Department of Defense.
