## DoD Funded Chartstrings

### **Purpose of this Guide**

The purpose of this guide is to determine if the grant chartstring you wish to use to book airfare for international travel is funded by the Department of Defense (DoD).

## **Background**

When booking travel to a grant chartstring, the Fly America Act requires the use of a United States flag carrier. One exception to the Fly America Act is if an Open Skies Agreement is in place. The exception is not applicable for DoD awards or DoD awards flowed through another institution to Northwestern. A U.S. flag carrier must be used on awards funded by the DoD for airfare. 
