Fall Protection: Authorized Person	29 CFR 1910.28	<a href="#">In-Person</a> required for designated "authorized persons" initially, conditionally (i.e., new job, responsibility, workplace changes, post-incident, supervisor discretion), and every 3 years thereafter	
Fall Protection: Competent Person	29 CFR 1910.28	<a href="#">In-Person</a> required for designated "competent persons" initially, conditionally (i.e., new job, responsibility, workplace changes, post-incident, supervisor discretion), and every 3 years thereafter
