However, I understand I have the right to revoke this authorization at any time, but my revocation must be submitted in writing and filed with Northwestern University's Office of Equity and my physician/primary healthcare provider. My decision to revoke this authorization will be effective immediately, except in the case that any provider referenced above already has relied on my authorization and released information.
