Rhodes v Marshall Application Requirements

ESSAYS

For the Rhodes, you may **NOT** seek essay assistance from anyone on your **personal statement**. Indeed, you and I (should you be nominated) have to declare that no one has provided feedback on that essay. By contrast, you **SHOULD** seek your mentors' input on your **academic proposal** before the campus deadline.

For Marshall, you need to have two, two year programs of study. The campus and national committees look for evidence that you have been in conversation with a mentor in the UK within the academic proposal essay. As with the Rhodes academic proposal, you **SHOULD** show your Marshall essay drafts to your academic mentors and get their feedback.

Members of our office will assist in the revision of the Rhodes academic essay and the Marshall essays following the campus endorsement process.

LETTERS

For Rhodes the 8 total breakdown as follows:

- **2 Field Academic** (taught you or supervised research as an undergraduate) in your field of specialty
- **2 Broad Academic** (taught/research) in other fields demonstrating intellectual breadth ideally covering the "literary attainments" qualification
- **3 Character/Leadership** letters from your college and post-bac years, which demonstrate your commitment to social service as well as your leadership ability in a variety of contexts
- **1 High School** letter that ideally encompasses both academic and leadership skills – ideally including evidence of athleticism

For Marshall the 3* breakdown as follows:

- **1 Preferred** letter that ideally provided evidence of your preparation for the academic proposal from someone who has taught you, supervised research, and gotten to know you well in your field of choice (from NU)
- **1 Additional Academic** who has taught you or supervised research (ideally from NU)
- **1 Leadership** letter again, need not be from NU

***Two of the three letters must be from within the US.**

The master's program will allow me to answer this question in my end of year thesis/project.


To prepare for that thesis/project, I will take classes about **A**, write short papers on topics **B & C** under the supervision of faculty members **D & E**.

Faculty member **Y** has expressed interest in supervising my thesis.


