Characteristics of a Clark and Hinman Fellow

Eligibility

- Current first- or second-year student
- A track record of dedication to society through service and/or scholarship
- All fields and majors accepted
- GPA of 3.3 and above
- Award cannot be combined with other NU grants or used for NU programs (e.g., CFS)

Application Components

- Resume
- Unofficial transcript
- One 300-word essay that articulates your vision for social change
- One 300-word essay that details how you plan to use the fellowship and why you need the money (e.g., support unpaid civil service or volunteering; undertake unpaid research related to service)
