You may wonder what a fellowship is. A fellowship can be

- a grant for a creative or research project
- a **scholarship** for an academic qualification
- an **internship** for professional development

What makes a grant, scholarship, or internship a **fellowship** is the cohort of people chosen to develop their talents together with guidance from mentors, through group activities, and in support of a larger goal.

This booklet lists the hundreds of Northwestern students and alumni who secured external funding during the 2020–21 academic year to create, research, study, and intern through fellowships across the country and around the globe. Because of the coronavirus pandemic, recipients may have been unable to use their awards in summer 2021 or during the academic year; to honor the achievement of their having been selected, we have announced awards regardless of postponements or cancellations.

Fellowships are listed in four categories:

- those requiring students to apply first to Northwestern for endorsement before filing an application to a national competition
- those offering international experiences by taking recipients outside the United States
- those taking recipients off campus to destinations within the United States
- those funding student activities on campus

Biomedical engineering major **Catherine Chen** graduated from the McCormick School of Engineering this year and is headed to Greensboro, Alabama, for the *Project Horseshoe Farm Fellowship*, which works to build on the strengths of local communities, improve health and quality of life for vulnerable populations, and prepare citizen service leaders.



**Raymonde Council**, a third-year materials science and engineering major in McCormick, spent the summer in Freiburg, Germany, through the *Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst Research Internship in Science and Engineering* (DAAD RISE), which places US undergraduates as research assistants for German PhD candidates.



**Orion Forowycz**, an alumnus of the DAAD RISE program and a graduate of the Weinberg College of Arts and Sciences with a double major in the integrated sciences program and physics, will spend the next two years abroad earning a graduate degree with support from the *Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters* award. He will begin in L'Aquila, Italy.



Thanks to the *Expanding Diversity in Economics* program, Weinberg junior economics major **Saul Galvez** studied last summer at the University of Chicago's Becker Friedman Institute for Economics, where he learned from leading scholars in the field and expanded his network of mentors.



This year, **Keerti Gopal**, a 2021 Weinberg graduate in American studies, will travel to Taiwan through the *Fulbright US Student Program* to conduct an independent research project on youth climate activism. Gopal also belongs to a select group of Fulbrighters who received the *National Geographic Storytelling Fellowship*.



**Wyatt Mosiman**, a junior in the Medill School of Journalism, Media, Integrated Marketing Communications, had a year full of fellowship successes. Through the *National Science Foundation Research Experiences for Undergraduates* program, she spent the summer in Minnesota with the Echinacea Project; this year, she will receive tuition support and an internship through the *National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Ernest F. Hollings Undergraduate Scholarship*.



After winning multiple research grants from Northwestern, senior **Haley Wellman**, a chemistry major in Weinberg, looked abroad for her next opportunity and secured the *ThinkSwiss Research Scholarship*, which funded her summer work on the triaxial supramolecular weave with the Wennemers Group, based at ETH Zürich in Switzerland.


