

SCRAP METAL RECYCLING PROCEDURES:

- All scrap metal items from FM Shops should be brought to the designated dumpster at 2020 Ridge, south of the Auto Shop.
- The dumpster is locked with access provided by Auto Shop personnel.
- Each shop delivering metal is responsible for loading the items into the dumpster. The dumpster is enclosed with a fully-opening door on the back end. There is space to back a truck up alongside the container for unloading/loading.
- Please load the dumpster as neatly as possible & notify Auto Shop personnel if it is full.
- If you have placed a significant quantity of heavy items into the dumpster, notify Auto Shop personnel. There is a 9 ton limit for hauling.
- The dumpster may be used for scrap metal from departments across campus as well.
- The dumpster is for internal use. Contractors are responsible for their own waste.

WHAT IS ACCEPTABLE:

- ALL ferrous and non-ferrous metals, including specialty foundry grades of steel, stainless steel, aluminum and all types of red metals.
- Metal items such as bookcases, shelves, bikes, appliances, desks, etc. are acceptable.
- Items must be safe to dispose -- any coolant or other hazardous materials must be removed before placement in the dumpster. The Office of Research Safety (ORS) can assist with any hazardous remediation or disposal issues, 1-5581.
