PARTNERSHIPS AND AGREEMENTS



DEVELOPING PARTNERSHIPS

We work with Northwestern schools and departments to strengthen and expand Northwestern's 80+ partnerships with some of the best institutions in the world.

What we do:

- Develop and expand Northwestern's institutional partnerships abroad
- Work with units and faculty to build partnerships, including customized study abroad programs, student and faculty exchanges, dual degree programs, and research collaborations

PROCESSING AGREEMENTS

We provide assistance with the design and negotiation of international collaborations, and process agreements that require a memorandum of understanding (MOU).

What we do:

- Create, edit, and approve agreements
- Consult with the Office of General Counsel, the Office for Research, and the Provost's Office on behalf of the sponsoring unit
- Provide online step-by-step guide to
 the Northwestern agreement process
- Maintain comprehensive database of international agreements

VISITORS



HOSTING VISITORS

We regularly host international visitors and delegations, and introduce them to Northwestern's cutting-edge research and teaching.

What we do:

- Schedule presentations and meetings with faculty and administrators, and plan visits to research labs and centers
- Give customized campus tours
- Provide assistance to Northwestern units hosting international visitors by providing presentation materials, appropriate gifts, and staff support
- Coordinate outreach to Chicago's diplomatic and international communities

ENGAGING FACULTY

We provide opportunities, including funding, for faculty members interested in developing or expanding their international portfolios.

What we do:

- Promote international collaborations by connecting Northwestern faculty with peers at partner institutions
- Organize exploratory visits to international partners
- Leverage faculty travel to strengthen partnerships and cultivate alumni
- Support and organize international workshops and conferences

CONNECTING STAFF

We engage and support staff in Northwestern's internationalization activities, and build community through our One World \ One Northwestern (OWON) initiative.

What we do:

- Organize quarterly networking events
- Lead professional development group
- Share institutional and industry
 updates through newsletters
- Assist in drafting grant proposals and award nominations
- Provide professional development opportunities at international partner and Big Ten institutions

CULTIVATING ALUMNI

We support Northwestern's international fundraising efforts through engaging and connecting with alumni living abroad.

What we do:

- Integrate alumni with student and faculty programming abroad
- Fundraise for international programs
 - · Host international alumni and donors
 - Give presentations on Northwestern's global activities
