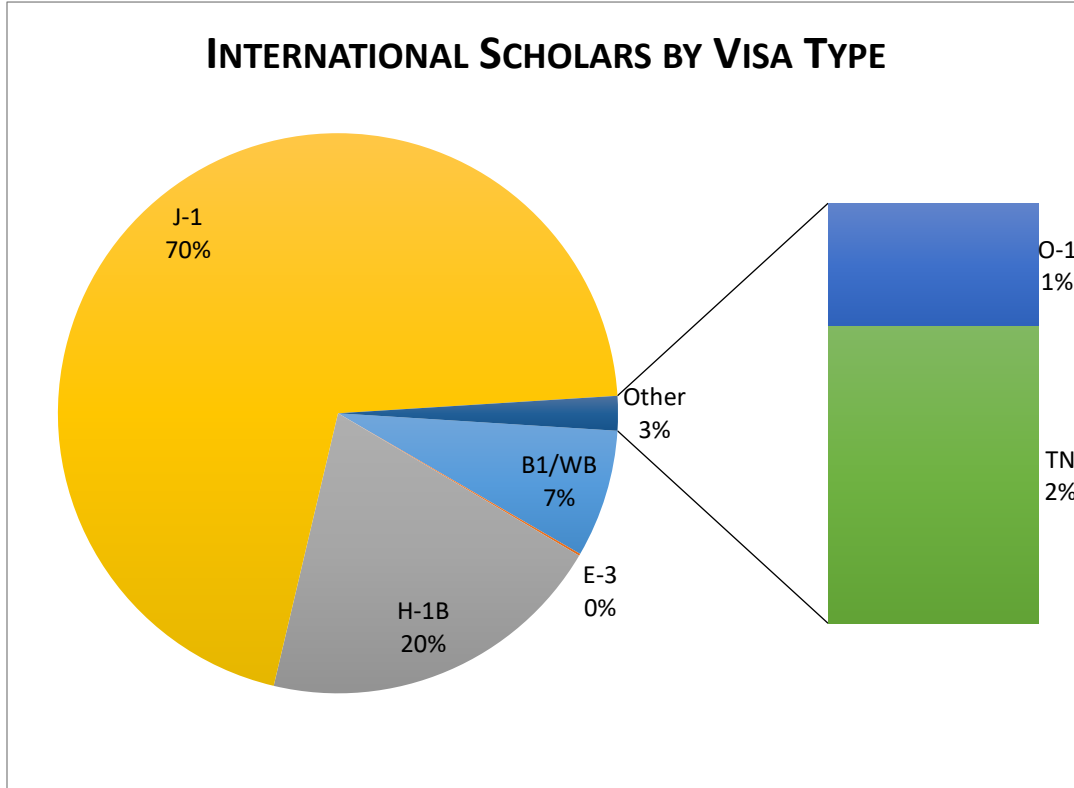


INTERNATIONAL SCHOLAR SUMMARY 2018
