U.S. immigration regulations require that J-1 Exchange Visitors check in with the OISS. Upon first entry to the U.S., submit this form, your I-94 record, your J-1 visa, and your J-1 orientation completion certificate to your [OISS advisor](#) via email to check-in. The OISS recommends keeping paper and scanned copies of your travel documents, including copies of your I-94 record (generated after each arrival to the U.S.) for safekeeping.
