Please submit application materials by Friday, February 21 to the Office of Residential Experience within Residential Services ([ResAcademicEngagement@northwestern.edu](mailto:ResAcademicEngagement@northwestern.edu)). A selection committee will review applications, and finalists will be invited for an interview. Final decisions will be announced in May 2025. Move-in for this position is anticipated for early September 2025.

#### Statement of Interest

Statements should not exceed 3 pages in length and should address the following:

- Why are you interested in the Faculty-in-Residence position?
- Describe any interactions you have had with undergraduates outside of the classroom (e.g., research mentorship, student organization advising, residential college affiliation, etc.).
- How does the residential experience enhance the undergraduate experience at Northwestern? Describe your involvement in programming supported by student affairs or Residential services at Northwestern or other institutions.
- How would you utilize the Faculty-in-Residence position to help achieve the [4 pillars of the residential experience](#)?
  - Community & Belonging
  - Student Agency
  - Care & Support
  - Academic Linkages
- List courses you have taught in the past three years that involve undergraduates. Briefly summarize your current research interests and responsibilities on campus.
