Winter Break Safety Tips!

If You're Traveling Home:

- <u>Unplug Appliances</u>: Reduce fire hazards by unplugging all non-essential appliances before leaving.
- Lock Up: Make sure all doors and windows are securely locked before you leave.
- <u>Inform Roommates</u>: Let your roommates know your travel plans to coordinate any shared responsibilities or security concerns.

- <u>Monitor Cooking:</u> Keep an eye on anything cooking in the kitchen to prevent accidental fires; never leave food unattended on the stove.
- <u>Check Smoke Detectors</u>: Test smoke detectors to ensure they're in working order.
- <u>Secure Your Apartment</u>: Lock doors and windows at all times, even when your home, to maintain security.
- <u>Coordinate with Roommates</u>: Discuss holiday plans to avoid unexpected guests or noise issues and respect any quiet hours.
- <u>Mind Occupancy Limits</u>: If hosting friends, be mindful of your apartment's occupancy limits and keep walkways clear for safety.

• <u>Be a Good Neighbor</u>: Let neighbors know if you're planning a gathering, communicate openly, and respect noise levels


What's New with OCL?
