
2023 Enrolled Student Survey Highlights

Overview- Enrolled Student Survey

- Biennially administered to all Evanston undergraduates
- Survey question ask students about topics that include:
 - Participation in activities in and out of the classroom
 - Perceptions about how their skills and abilities have changed since enrolling at Northwestern
 - Sources of advice about academic, career, and personal choices
 - Feeling of health and well being
- Also administered by COFHE peer institutions





Response rates were progressively lower as student class year advanced




By Class Year

Overall, how satisfied have you been with your undergraduate education so far?




There were large differences between the highest and lowest rated aspects of the Northwestern experience










Most student feel like part of the NU community, but results were more mixed across race/ethnic groups




Tell us how much you agree or disagree with each of these statements.



Although most students agreed they can freely express their views and engage in respectful dialogue on difficult topics, the levels of disagreement are high




Overall, most students agreed they have school-life balance, but there were differences by racial/ethnic groups




How satisfied are you with your ability to balance academics and other aspects of your life?




School-life balance was fairly consistent across schools




Concerns about future plans and managing course workload were the largest sources of stress for students



Below are potential sources of stress that you may experience as a student. Please indicate how each has affected you during the current academic year.




Northwestern students have progressively held more liberal political views over the last decade; though the trend reversed from 2021 to 2023




Students reported high levels of engagement with faculty




To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?

Is there at least one faculty member at Northwestern who has taken a personal interest in your success?




Most seniors knew multiple faculty members well enough to provide a letter of recommendation




How many faculty members know you well enough to provide a letter of recommendation in support of an application for a job, internship, fellowship, or advanced degree work?


The share of students identifying as a gender other than male or female is growing




The diversity of the sexual orientation of students continues to grow



Most students in each class year, except first-year, had a paying job




There are variations across race/ethnicity and school in the share of students who had a paying job, but most students in every sub-group reported having a paying job




Student organizations and academic groups were the most popular extracurricular activities
