Policy on Faculty Family Leave

Northwestern provides paid family leave to eligible faculty for childbearing, adoption, and child-rearing. Faculty should consult this policy's website for information and FAQs about types and length of leave, eligibility, and the application process.

Policy on Extension of the Probationary Period for Tenure-Track Faculty Faculty members may request extensions of their probationary period for birth, adoption, or child-rearing or in cases where other circumstances have arisen to interfere substantially with research and/or other projects that faculty members must submit as part of tenure review.

DEPENDENT CARE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE		
Portable Caregiving Grant	Eligible faculty can receive a grant of up to \$1,500 to help offset caregiving costs for dependent children and adult or senior dependents.	northwestern.edu/hr/benefits/work -life/paying-for-childcare/portable -caregiving-grant.html
Childcare Fee Assistance	Northwestern allocates funds for fee assistance at community childcare centers to eligible faculty.	northwestern.edu/hr/benefits/work -life/paying-for-childcare/childcare -fee-assistance.html
