- Kären Wigen is the Frances and Charles Field Professor in History in the School of Humanities and Sciences at Stanford University.
- Wigen was formerly the Chair of the History Department (2011 - 2014).
- She previously served as Director of the Center for East Asian Studies (2009 - 2011).
- Wigen teaches Japanese history and the history of cartography.
- Her first book, *The Making of a Japanese Periphery, 1750-1920* (1995), mapped the economic transformation of southern Nagano Prefecture during the heyday of the silk industry. Her second book, *A Malleable Map: Geographies of Restoration in Central Japan, 1600-1912* (2010), returned to the ground of that study, exploring the roles of cartography, chorography, and regionalism in the making of modern Shinano. She co-authored *The Myth of Continents* (1997) with Martin Lewis. Her latest book is another collaboration, *Time in Maps: From the Age of Discovery to Our Digital Era*, coedited with Caroline Winterer (2020).
- She presently serves on a number of boards, committees and professional organizations including Advisory Editor of the Oxford Research Encyclopedia of Asian History, Chair of the Bentley Prize Committee, American Historical Association, Nominating Committee for the American Historical Association, and Editorial Board member of *Cross-Currents: East Asian History and Culture Review*.
- Wigen earned her PhD in Geography from the University of California at Berkeley.
