


CLASS OF 2020 EMPLOYMENT

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

As part of the 2021 Post-Graduation Survey (one source of information for this study), recent graduates were given a list of 21 experiential learning opportunities and asked to check all those in which they had participated as undergraduates. 572 recent graduates responded to this question.

86.01% reported that they had engaged in one or more experiential learning opportunities.

INTERNSHIPS

70.63% reported that they had participated in one or more internship experiences.

RESEARCH

56.57% reported that they had participated in one or more research experiences.

DEEP INVOLVEMENT

92.29% reported that they had been "deeply" involved in one or more student organizations, clubs, or varsity athletics.
