**Move-in Process** 

## Early Arrivals

- Must be approved and begin as early as September 11th
- Arrive any time 24/7 and in almost all cases move to their Fall Quarter assignment
- \$50 a night
- Students check in with the emailed Self-Check In link
   ✓ Stop by your Area Desk if you need a Wildcard, to check out a moving cart, or for general questions
   ✓ No move-in assistance is available for early arrivals

## **Move-In Process – September 17**

- Print the move-in permit and place on your dashboard (if you are driving)
  - Permits are scheduled to be emailed on September 6
- Complete the Self-Check In Form that will be emailed to you on the morning of September 17
- Arrive to your designated unloading zone at the time on the move-in permit (if driving) or go straight to your building if not in a vehicle
  - Do not drive to your building use the address provided for the unloading zone on the move-in permit and on the move-in website

## **Move-In Process – September 17**

- Professional movers will meet you at your vehicle and move items to the room
  - Once unloaded, one person must move your vehicle to a long-term parking location
    - North Campus Parking Garage, South Campus Parking Garage, South Campus Parking Structure
    - Ryan Field (a shuttle is available throughout the day)
      - *Peer Advisers will hand you a map while you are in your unloading zone*
- Quickly meet RAs as you enter your building lobby and complete the Self-Check In if you have not yet done so
- Tap your card on your door, wait 60 seconds, then tap again
- Go to your room and unpack
  - No time limit, but events start at 4:00 p.m.
- Visit the Wildcat Welcome Center in the Louis Room of the Norris University Center
- Need assistance? Talk to a Resident Assistant or visit your Area Desk.










### **Parking After Unloading**

## Answer to Pre-Submitted Questions

Family members and friends can assist with move in – no limits on numbers; you can come back to visit (with roommate approval) No move-in assistance is provided outside of the 17th (moving carts are available); area desks are open 24/7 for assistance

Consider shopping in the area or ship items to arrive on or after September 3

At the end of the year, summer storage and shipping options are available through our approved vendor (USS)

Must bring items: a fan, headphones. Visit our "Things to Bring" list on the website. Storage is not available outside of the student room; summer storage is available through a vendor

Shipping to campus – USS and Litterbox are the only NU vendors who can place items into student rooms prior to arrival

## **Supporting Your Student**

- Early stages of transition yields to quicker emotional drain
  - Wellness Break times listed throughout a student's schedule + an index of recommendations
  - Required programming does not begin before 9:00 a.m. and ends by 10 p.m.
- Building social connections in the first weeks feels challenging
  - It takes 60 hours to move from acquaintance to casual friendship & 100 hours to call someone a friend
  - Help manage expectations & utilization of residential area, PA Group, & programs
- Join them in navigating & discovering resources
  - Walk through websites together to help them continue learning how to navigate & access help
  - While you navigate together, ensure they take the lead to contact for support or with additional questions
