- Are you wanting to found this organization to fulfill a university requirement?
- Is your proposed organization part of a broader regional/national/international organization?
 - If yes, please provide the national organization's name, website, and the contact information for your liaison with the national organization.
- To the best of your knowledge, has this organization existed at Northwestern before? If so, what approximate date was is last active?
- What is your organization's purpose and intended goals?
- How does your proposed organization's goals/purpose align with the university's mission?
- What need will your organization serve that is not already served on campus? Which current active
 organizations most closely offer what you propose with the organization and where are there
 distinctions?
- What are your organization's proposed activities/events in the first year to offer value to the Northwestern community?
