Note: Space and resources on campus are limited, so consider how your proposed organization will function within these limitations.
- What financial resources will you need in your first year and how do you plan to obtain those resources? Note: Campus Life does not allocate direct funding for organizations, however there are a select number of grants available for organizations to apply. Please be as specific as you can regarding plans to fundraise or procure what your organization needs.
- Organization Charter Members (at least 5): Please upload an excel spreadsheet with the (1) Name, (2) Email, (3) Phone Number, (4) Class Year, and (5) Position Title (if applicable) for each member.
- Is your proposed organization open to any student who wishes to join?
- What restrictions do you foresee for membership to your proposed organization?
 - Consider the following questions as you formulate your response: Will there be costs associated with participation? Is prior experience required? Is membership limited to a certain number of people?
- What is your intended membership recruitment process?
- Is there anything else the committee should know about your proposed student organization?
