## Ogilvie/Streeterville Express

Bus service on the #120 Ogilvie/Streeterville Express route runs on weekdays during AM and PM rush periods, between the Ogilvie Transportation Center and Streeterville. Service runs generally every 7-15 minutes, in both directions.

End-to-end trips take ~15 min and run with limited stops and non-stop express via Lower Wacker between Ogilvie and Streeterville/Magnificent Mile area.



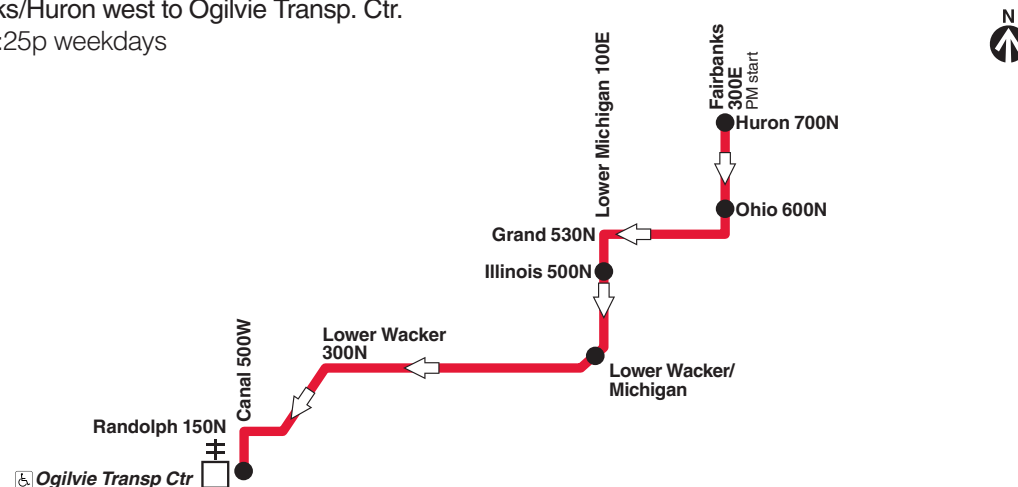
### AM peak-direction routing

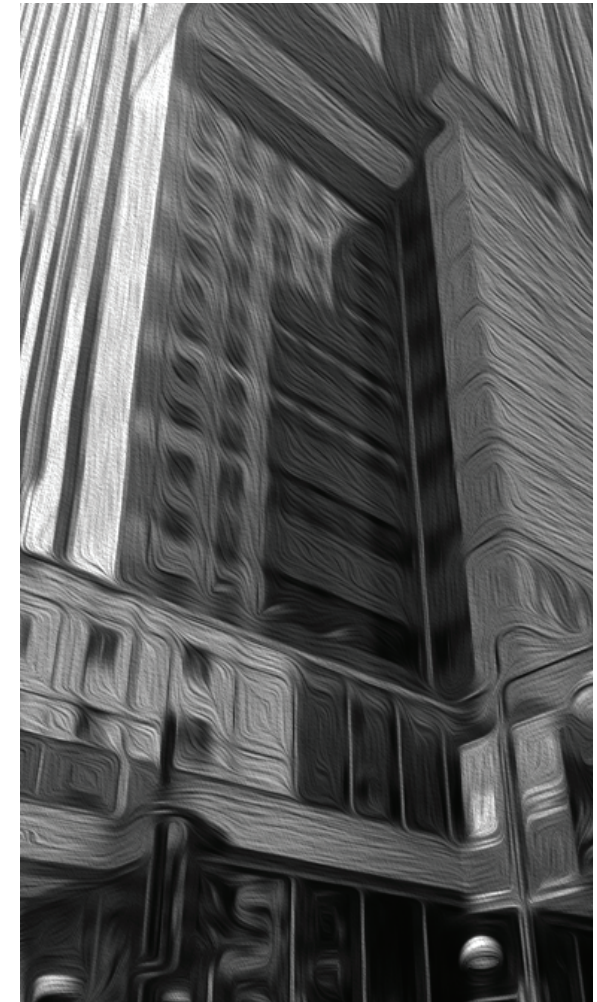

## Buses from Union Station & Ogilvie T.C. to Streeterville Medical Campus

Welcome aboard!



CTA bus routes #120 and #121 provide fast, frequent and nearly direct weekday rush period service between Ogilvie and Union stations and the Streeterville area, including the Streeterville Medical Campus.

Buses start/end trips at either commuter rail station and make limited stops while also running express via Lower Wacker Drive for an even faster trip.

Both routes, from end-to-end, are about a 15 minute trip and run in both directions during both the AM and PM peak periods.

How to ride

Wait at a designated stop for your route for the next bus and be visible as the bus approaches if not at a terminal so the driver knows you want to board.

Some bus stops have live arrival information, but you can also easily find next arrivals at [ctabustracker.com](http://ctabustracker.com), in apps like the Ventra app or Google Maps or by following text instructions on the bus stop sign.

When approaching your stop, pull the stop cord (above the windows) or press a stop button on poles inside the bus to let the driver know you wish to exit.

How to pay

All CTA buses have farecard readers at the front of the bus and also take cash/coin. Pay as you board.

Bus fare is \$2.25 when paying with a farecard (such as a plastic Ventra Card or a virtual Ventra Card loaded into your phone via the Ventra app). You can also pay bus fare with any standard contactless bankcard, including those loaded into your phone for contactless payments.

If paying directly with cash, bus fare is \$2.50 (no transfers available).

If you buy Metra Monthly Tickets, consider adding a Regional Connect Pass for \$30 to your Ventra Card in the Ventra App for unlimited CTA rides, too!

121 Union/Streeterville Express

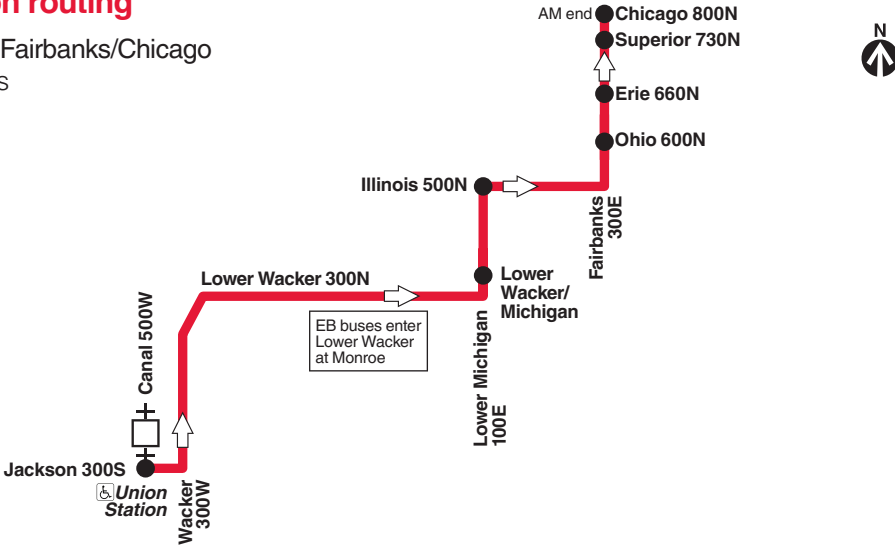
Bus service on the #121 Union/Streeterville Express runs on weekdays during AM and PM rush periods, between the the Union Station Transit Center (bus terminal at Jackson/Canal) and Streeterville. Service runs generally every 7-15 minutes, in both directions.



End-to-end trips take ~15 min and run with limited stops and non-stop express via Lower Wacker between Union Station and the south end of Streeterville/Magnificent Mile area.

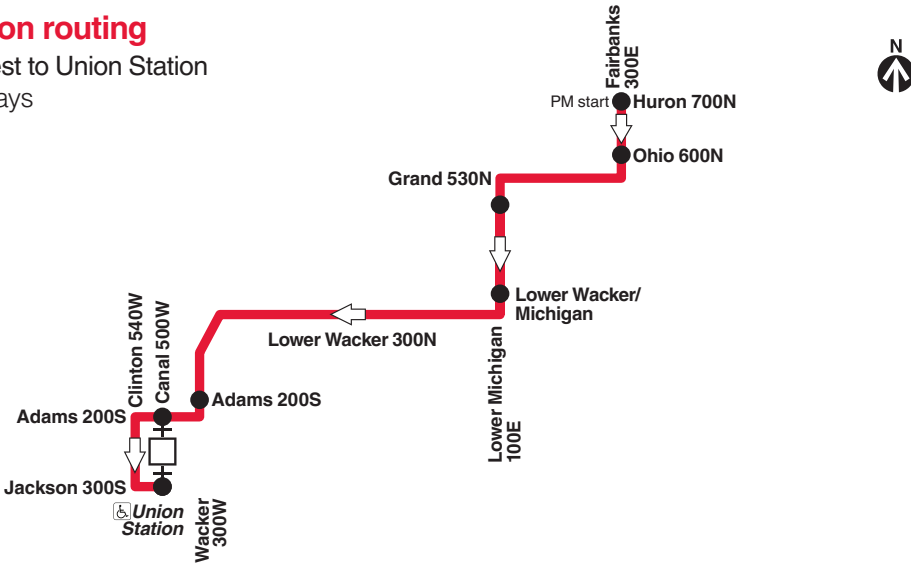
AM peak-direction routing

PM peak-direction routing

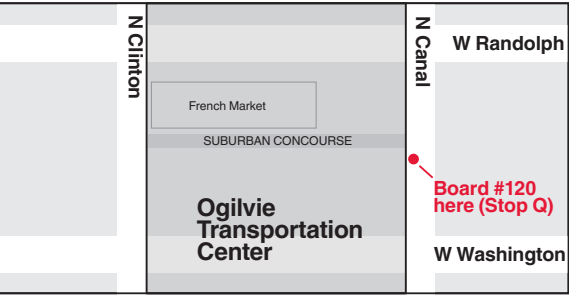
Fairbanks/Huron west to Union Station

Tips on where to board

From Ogilvie Transportation Center

Board #120 buses on southbound Canal next to the train shed of the station (you can exit toward the center of platforms to the Suburban Concourse—the corridor with entry to the French Market) at **Stop Q**. Canal is the street on the east side of the station.



From Chicago Union Station

Board #121 buses from the Union Station Transit Center (USTC/bus terminal) at the southwest corner of Jackson/Canal (just south of the Great Hall).

From the south concourse within the station, follow overhead signs to CTA Buses for an accessible, underground pedway connection directly to the bus terminal, or, if you exit the station to street, simply make your way to the bus terminal at Jackson/Canal.

Board #121 buses at **Stop C** in the USTC bus terminal.
